

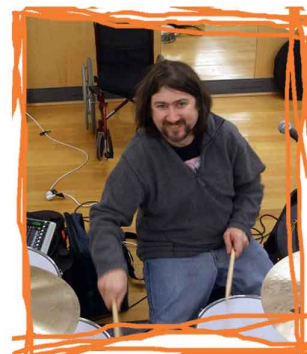

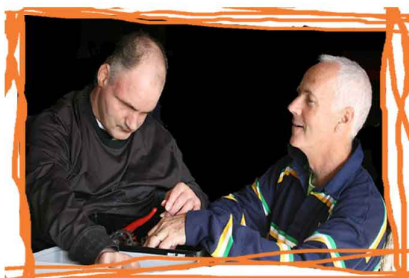
Andrew Hewitt
